Canadian Culture: Research Project

Culture is defined as the social behavior and norms found in human societies, as well as the knowledge, beliefs, arts, laws, customs, capabilities, and habits of the individuals in these groups.

For this assignment, you will choose an aspect of **Canadian Culture** (People, Places, Language, **Food, Traditions, Holiday, Religion, etc..)** and then research, write a short research paper, and then present your topic to the class on **Monday, November 9th**.

Your research information will be focused around these simple questions:

"Why is it important to Canadians and people living in Canada?"

<u>or</u>

"How is/are _(cultual aspect)_ in Canada different from / similar to _(cultual aspect)_ in my home country?"

- The written research portion of your project need to be a minimum of 5 paragraphs, (1 introductory, 3 body paragraphs, and 1 concluding paragraph) and the first draft is due on Monday, November 2nd, 2020
- The good copy of your written research paper is due Thursday, November 5th, 2020.
- Your **presentation** can be done as: <u>a poster</u>, <u>a slideshow</u>, or <u>a pre-recorded video</u>. We will present our research projects to the class on **Monday**, **November 9**th, **2020**.
