

## Christmas Fractions Worksheet



1.Santa has 30 gifts to deliver to the students of division 10. 5 of them are Nerf Guns, 10 of them are Video Games, 3 of them are stuffed toys and the remaining 12 are books.

Create a fraction to represent each of the gifts, as well as a visual representation of each fraction.

2.Kale and Josh were putting up stocking around the class. Maya and Chloe S each made a couple of red ones with Snowmen, while Kyle and Koby made 2 green stockings with Santa Claus on them. James and Leanne got in on the action too, James made a white one with a reindeer, and another red one with an elf. Leanne chose 2 green stockings, both with snowmen on them.

Create a list of fractions based on the stockings made by Division 10 students, as well as a visual representation of the different colours of stockings, and the different items that appear on them.
